

Privacy Policy

Protecting your private information is our priority. This Statement of Privacy applies to www.ieple.com and iEple LLC and governs data collection and usage. For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to iEple LLC include www.ieple.com, iEple.com, iEple LLC, www.ieple.com and www.ieple.com. Collection of your Personal Information

iEple.com may collect personally identifiable information, such as your:

- Name

- Address

- E-mail Address

- Phone Number

Please keep in mind that if you directly disclose personally identifiable information or personally sensitive data through iEple.com's public message boards, this information may be collected and used by others.

Use of your Personal Information

iEple.com collects and uses your personal information to operate its website(s) and deliver the services you have requested.

iEple.com may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from iEple.com and its affiliates. iEple.com may also contact you via surveys to

conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

iEple.com does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties.

iEple.com may share data with trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to iEple.com, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

iEple.com may keep track of the websites and pages our users visit within iEple.com, in order to determine what iEple.com services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within iEple.com to customers whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

iEple.com will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on iEple.com or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of iEple.com; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of iEple.com, or the public.

Automatically Collected Information

Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by iEple.com. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the iEple.com website.

Security

We take precautions to protect your information. When you submit sensitive information via the website, your information is protected both online and offline.

Whenever we collect sensitive information (such as credit card data) that information is encrypted and transmitted to us in a secure way. You can verify this by looking for a closed lock icon at the bottom of your web browser, or looking for "https" at the beginning of the address of the webpage.

While we use encryption to protect sensitive information transmitted online, we also protect your information offline. Only employees who need the information to perform a specific job (for example, billing or customer service) are granted access to personally identifiable information. The computers/servers in which we store personally identifiable information are kept in a secure environment.

Use of Cookies

The iEple.com website may use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you,

and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize iEple.com pages, or register with iEple.com site or services, a cookie helps iEple.com to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same iEple.com website, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the iEple.com features that you customized.
